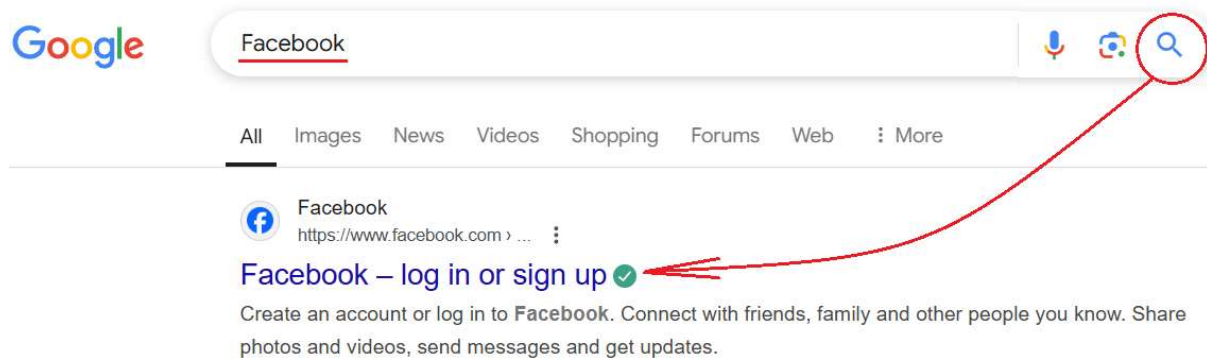


Creating an Account in Facebook

The password must be a combination of six numbers, letters and special characters such as !, \$ and &.

You can use your email or mobile number as your login.

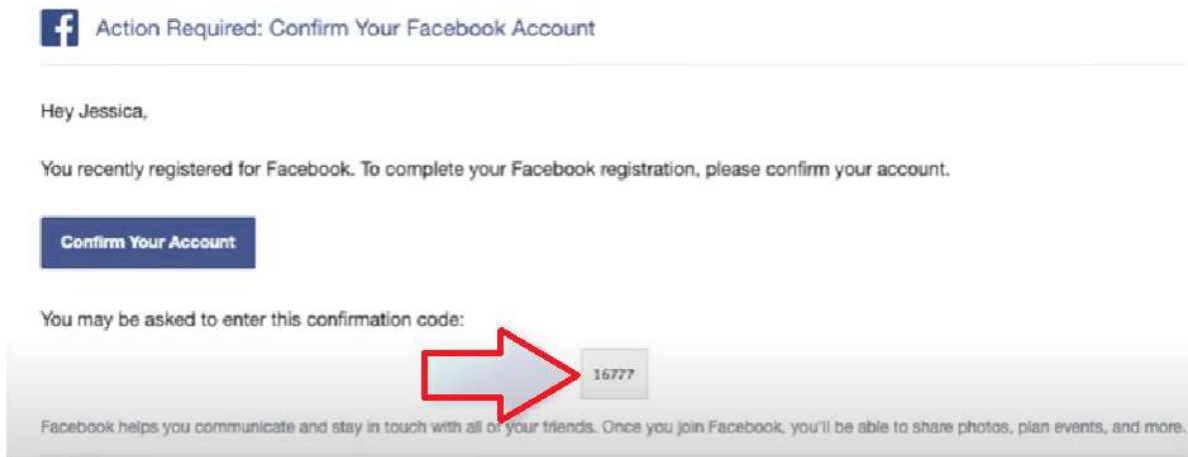

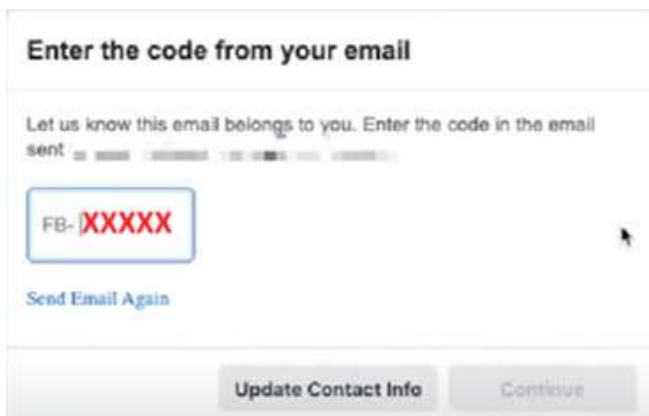
When you have clicked “Sign Up” you will receive a text or email with a code to enter.

Enter the code to complete your Facebook registration.

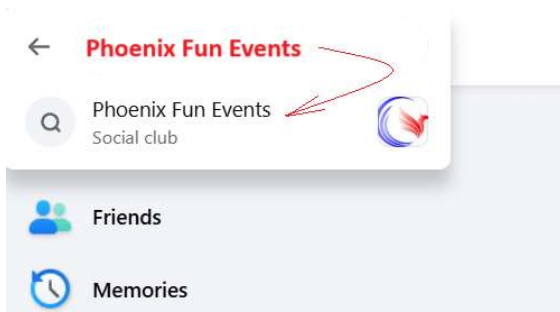


You will receive confirmation your account has been verified. Click OK.
